

Why did Jesus Die?



1. Because we are all sinners!

MAREKO 2:17 Ngke E ongo Iesu, ao E taku nakoia, Te koraki aika a marurung, a aki kainnanao te tia katoki aoraki, ma e kainnanaoaki irouia aika a aoraki: I roko, tiaki bwa N na weteia akana raoiroi, ma I roko bwa N na weteia akana buaakaka.

ROM 3:10 n ai aron are e koreaki ni kaangai: Akea te aomata ae e eti arona, bon akea temanna; akea ae atatai;

Mataio 18:11 “For the Son of man is come to save that which was lost.”

2. Because there is a cost for that sin!

Mataio 15:18-20 Ma te bwai ae e nako man te wi e nako man te nano, ao boni ngaia ae e kamwaraaea te aomata. There is a cost for sin!

3. Because Jesus died and paid for our sins on the cross!

MATAIO 1:21 Ane e na bungia te nati te mwaane, ao ko na aranna bwa Iesu, bwa Ngaia ae E na kamaiuua ana aomata man aia bure.

ROM 5:8 Ma te Atua, E kaota oin ana tangira nakoira n aei: bwa ngke bon taani bure ngaira, ao E mate Kristo i bukira.

IOANE 3:16 Bwa E tangira aonnaba te Atua n te aro are E anga natina ae te rikitemanna iai, bwa e aonga n aki mate ane e onimakinna, ma e na reke irouna te maiu are e aki toki.
