

Why did Jesus Die?



1. Because we are all sinners!

Maarkō 2:17 Kii nēē teer :Yēesu kilēē nyoonēē, kuwālchi kilē, "Wāsootēy :piich choo mnyoonchootēēn cheepsaakityaan. Māwāsootēy :choo kāroomō pōōrwēy. Kyoochōōn akuur kipng'ōōkiis, amēēlē chēpō man."

Rooma 3:10 Mwoorēy :siruut kilē, "Moomii :chiich mpō ākoong'o nyoo pēērēy keey.

Matthew 18:11 Āmwoorwook man kilē mii :malaykeenikwaak taayuu Paapeenyuun nkōō kipsēnkwēt.

2. Because there is a cost for that sin!

Matthew 15:18-20 Wōloo nyuun tukun choo pkoonēē kuutii chiich kupkoonēē mukulēr aku-irēy :choochēē chiich kumātililiit. Āmu pkoonēē kaapkootuut chaa raacheen mukulēr nyēpō chiich. Irēy kaapkootuutēchoochēē piich kurumiisyō, kusiir karwa, ku-ir takal kutoomō kwoop keey, kuchōōrsyō, kung'uurnaana, akung'alaala piich nkōō oor nyaa ra. Tukuuchochēē choo irēy chiich kumātililiit. Nēē āmiisyō :chiich amaatililil ēēr, kimā-irēy :nyoonēē chiich kumātililiit."

Rooma 6:23 Kunyuun, mālāk nyēpō :ng'ōōki ku meerat. Ku kōōnunō nyēpō :Iriin ku sopoon nyēpō ākōy kupunuunō Yēesu Kiriistō Kiptaayaantēēnyoon.

Maarkō 16:16 Chiich aka tōkōl nyoo keeran ng'aleechuuch /akeepaatiisan, /kēēsāruuy. Ku nyoo mēērānēy ng'aleechuuch, kēētilchinii kiirwook.



There is a cost for sin!

3. Because Jesus died and paid for our sins on the cross!

Mataayo 1:21 Tuumēy laakwa nyoo lēē wēerii /ākēēkuurēē wēeroonēē Yēesu. Itē kaarinaanoonēē āmu sāruuy piichiich nkōō ng'ōōkikwaak." (Kaarinaani lēē Yēesu kung'uutuuy mu kuutii Kirik kilē 'Sāruuy :Iriin piich.')

Rooma 5:8 Aku nyuun, kiing'utwēēch :Iriin choomnyēēnyiin āmu mpō ntā kiikiichaan kipng'ōōkiin kuuyooku Kiriistō kichō kima akipō achaan.

Chowaana 3:16 Kiicham :Iriin ng'wēny kitya ākōy kukōōnu Wēēriinyiin nyoo kii lēē ākoong'o kipaap, simāpēt :chiich aka tōkōl nyoo rānēy inyeentee aku tākunyōōru sopoon nyēpō ākōy.

Matthew 18:11 Āmwoorwook man kilē mii :malaykeenikwaak taayuu Paapeenyuun nkōō kipsēnkwēt.

4. Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God's word for it, and trust Jesus alone!

Pāyiisyōōnik 4:12 Māmii :chiich aka nkōō kōōrēē tōkōl nyoo kiikōōnu :Iriin nyoo muukēy kusār wēēch. Yēesu ākityōōn nyoo muukēy kusār wēēch."

Ēpēsō 2:8-9 Iriin kipaap nyoo ki-ir /kēēsārwook nkōō chamateenyiin, paani kyaaran inyeentee. Mēēlē kyaa-ir :akwaan kir /tākēēsārwook, wōloo nyuun kir nyoonēē nyoo kikōōnu :Iriin kipaap. Kimalas keyy nyuun :chiich kilē /kiikēēsāru, āmu makusāruuy chiich akipō tukun choo kāroomēēn choo ka-ir.

Tiitō 3:5 Maasār wēēch āmu kiku-ir tukun choo kāroomēēn. Kiisār wēēch āmu kiiriireeneech. Ki-istoowēēch :Iriin ng'ōōkiichooch akukōōnēēch sopoon nyoo rēēl kupunuunō Toomirmiiryenyiin.

5. We must put our faith and trust in Christ alone!

Maarkō 9:23 Kumwoochi :Yēesu kilē, "Āmu nee siimwaara kilē 'Nēē imuukēy'? Muukēē :kir aka tōkōl nkōō chiich nyoo rānēy Iriin."

Maarkō 1:15 Kyoomtooy kilē, "Kaaku-it :pērēētuu! Kaaku-itu :Pāyuunātoo Iriin. Āwāliisyēē nkōō ng'ōōkiikwook akaaran lōkōōy choo kāroomēēn."

Maarkō 10:15 Āmwoorwook man kilē, chiich nyoo mātookēy pāyuunātoo Iriin kilēē wōloo lēē laakwa, ku māchuutēy Kaa Iriin."

Rooma 10:9-10,13 Nēē mwaaree :kuutiing'uung' kilē 'Yēesu ku Kiptaayaan,' akiiranee moong'uung' kilē kiing'eeta :Iriin meerat, /kēēsāruun āmu, rānēē :chiich moonyiin ng'ālyoon tākuchama, /ākēēsāru nēē mwaara :kuutiinnyiin kiyoo keeran. āmu mwoorēy :siruut kilē "/Kusāruuy chiich aka tōkōl nyoo riirchinii Kiptaayaan."



Put your faith in Christ alone!
